### **Essential Surveys – A38 between Little Eaton and Coxbench, Derbyshire**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential surveys on the A38 Northbound between Little Eaton and Coxbench. These surveys will help us identify areas of repair.

#### **A38 Northbound**

##### **When we'll be working**

We plan to start this work from **10 July to 16 July**.

Please note that all planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances. We will write out to you again if there are any changes to the dates.

##### **How will this affect traffic?**

To carry out this work safely, we will need to close lanes on the A38 northbound between the hours of 20:00 to 06:00

We will also need to close the following slip roads at Coxbench between the hours of 20:00 to 06:00.

- southbound exit slip road from A38,
- northbound entry to the A38
- northbound exit from the A38.

During the slip road closures, we'll put in place fully signed diversion routes through the A38, A610 and B6179.

##### **What we're doing to reduce disruption**

We will keep the carriageway and slip roads open as normal during the daytime.

To minimise disruption we will work overnight, between **8pm and 6am** when the roads are quieter.

I apologise for any disruption this may cause you. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum. We would like to thank you for your patience during this work.

We have been and will continue to work closely with key local stakeholders in the area, including local authorities and businesses. We are eager to work with you to maximise opportunities to minimise disruption. We are happy to facilitate any additional work such as litter picking and other maintenance activities you may wish to carry out during our proposed road closure.
